## **Crime/Incident Breakdown**

### **MULGRAVE GGN**

14/03/2019 – Aislaby – Sometime between 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019 Unknown offender(s) have approached a Silver Peugeot 206 which was parked to the rear of Main Road and poured superglue into the lock of the petrol cap rendering it inoperable, No suspects have been identified and no further lines of enquiry.

15/03/2019 – Hutton Mulgrave – Sometime between 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> March 2019 unknown offenders have approached a Farm at Hutton Mulgrave and stolen a number of sheep (3 ewes and 4 lambs) No suspects have been identified and no further lines of enquiry.

22/03/2019 – Staithes – Sometime overnight of 21<sup>st</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019 unknown offenders have approached a property on Seaton Crescent and stolen a Grey Moped from the garden, the Moped was located behind the fish & chip shop on Staithes Lane and recovered by the owner No suspects have been identified and no further lines of enquiry.

22/03/2019 – Hinderwell – Between 09:00 – 10:00 on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019 two males with five dogs were seen in a field to the rear of Browns Terrace, the males were loading the dogs into a grey people carrier and were seen to leave towards Staithes, Police enquiries are ongoing to establish who was using the vehicle.

31/03/209 – Staithes – Sometime between 20:00 hours on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2019 – 09:00 on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 unknown offenders have a approached a garage on Whitegate Close Staithes and caused damage to the rear window by smashing it, Police enquiries are ongoing.

31/03/2019 – 12:40 – Hinderwell – Police stopped a White Volkswagen van on Station Road, the driver was spoken to by Police and requested to provide a sample for a Roadside drug test, the driver was subsequently arrested on suspicion of driving whilst having a controlled drug above the specified limit. Police enquiries are ongoing.

There have been a number of reports regarding door to door sellers in the Hinderwell, Runswick Bay and Port Mulgrave areas, the door to door sellers are offering household items and Fish for

sale, generally the Fish is offered at excessive prices and the sellers tend to target vulnerable or more elderly residents, Please remain vigilant and report any concerns to Police.

There have been Six road traffic collisions in the parish this month no injuries have been reported.

### **DANBY GGC**

05/03/2019 – Danby – Between 19:30 hours 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019 – 08:30 hours 5<sup>th</sup> March 2019 offenders have approached a property on Lodge Lane and entered an enclosed courtyard, they have then broken into a secure shed by forcing the lock and stolen a Green Honda Quad Bike before making off towards the Stokesley direction. Police enquiries are ongoing.

16/03/2019 – Castleton – Police seized an Orange Kia Sportage from the Castleton area on behalf of HM Customs after checks revealed that the owner was using red diesel in the vehicle. HM Customs officers have taken on the investigation and prosecution as it lies within their jurisdiction.

There have been no road traffic collisions in the parish this month.

### **ESK VALLEY GGF**

10/03/2019 – Goathland – Police received a report from a dog walker that an altercation had taken place near to Mallyan Spout which resulted in a verbal argument over right of way on a narrow bridge, this escalated to one party pushing the other to the floor. Police enquiries are ongoing.

26/03/2019 - Sleights – Offenders have approached land on Eskdaleside and stolen a 10 ft galvanised steel gate from a sheep pen before making off unseen in unknown direction No suspects have been identified and no further lines of enquiry.

There have been four road traffic collisions in the parish this month two resulted in no injuries however a Male suffered some minor injuries following a single vehicle collision at Fairhead Lane, Grosmont.

## **FYLINGDALES GGJ**

**No incidents of note to report this month.**

We are now able to supply an update in relation to the three males that were arrested in Fylingthorpe on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2018 for Theft. The three offenders appeared at York Crown Court on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019 where the judge jailed all three for a combined period of 48 months.
