Highways issues. The Clerk reported that the problem with blocked offsets on the Blakey Road had been reported as directed as had potholes on New Road j/w Dibble Bank and under the railway bridge near The Esk PH. None of these issues have been addressed and the entry on the Parish Portal reads: "Your request has been passed to a highways inspector for further investigation. We aim to undertake inspections for private works within 20 days. Once the inspection is completed we will update your case."

6. **Planning Applications**

Members considered the following Planning Application.

- 6.1 NYM/2024/0298 Application for installation of replacement composite front door at 15 Church Street, Castleton. Resolved – no objection.
- 6.2 NYM/2024/0378 Application for non material amendment to planning approval NYM/2021/0439/FL to allow a render finish in lieu of cladding, slate effect tiles to roof, alterations to fenestration and rooflights and installation of two sun tunnels at 27 West Lane, Danby. Resolved – no objection.
- 6.3 NYM/2024/0327 Application to construct a stone wall at Park Nook Farm, Langburns Bank, Castleton. Resolved – no objection.
- 6.4 NYM/2024/0308 & 0309 in relation to the old piggery adjacent to 5 Ashfield Road, Castleton. Application to rebuild & for Listed Building consent ref sections of wall and roof, internal pinning, re-hanging of door to west elevation and installation of door south elevation together with drainage works. b) NYMNPA – New North York Moors Design Code. Discussed and considered by members but no comments made at this time. NFA at this time.

9. Items reported by Councillors

- a) Dibble Bridge Bank (Castleton end) The blocked drain running under the road continues to be an issue the excessive amount of standing water at the road side has damaged to edge of the road which is now breaking up.
- b) Danby Beacon road – a number of potholes / poor road condition.
- c) Commondale – concerns raised by residents re speeding vehicles / cyclists entering the village from the direction of Kildale. The designated 30 MPH zone starts inside the boundary of the village. Request to be made to Highways to extend the 30 MPH zone and move the sign accordingly.
- d) Easton Lane / Castle Lane – blocked drain / gully
- e) Maddy House westward to the Parish boundary and beyond– pot holes / poor road condition
- f) Grass cutting – signs to be put up near the bakery Brier Hill, Danby to explain why the grass is no being cut in that area.
